



## **First Step Supportive Living Program**

The Supportive Living Program at Fairbanks (SLP) offers an opportunity for men and women to transition from rehab to outpatient treatment or recovery management programming while living in long-term residential housing.

First Step Supportive Living provides a structured environment where individuals can develop and practice life skills while maintaining a drug and alcohol-free lifestyle. Residents are encouraged to stay at SLP for at least nine weeks; however, many choose to stay longer. SLP is located in Indianapolis on the city bus line with access to I-465 and I-69.

## **SLP** services provided include:

- Literacy program Adult learning program is provided if needed for individuals living in SLP.
- Job readiness program Residents learn important skills to obtain employment.
- Employment agency Job application assistance is provided by an employment agency.
- Financial counseling Residents learn financial management and budgeting skills.
- Healthcare Access to affordable healthcare services is provided by the Wishard Advantage program.
- Transportation A Fairbanks van provides transportation for residents.
- Food pantry Opportunities for shopping at the Fairbanks food pantry are provided weekly.
