



## First Step Supportive Living Program

The Supportive Living Program at Fairbanks (SLP) offers an opportunity for men and women to transition from rehab to outpatient treatment or recovery management programming while living in long-term residential housing.

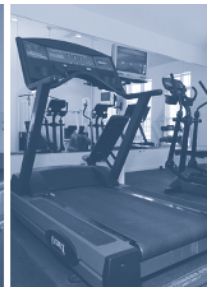
First Step Supportive Living provides a structured environment where individuals can develop and practice life skills while maintaining a drug and alcohol-free lifestyle. Residents are encouraged to stay at SLP for at least nine weeks; however, many choose to stay longer. SLP is located in Indianapolis on the city bus line with access to I-465 and I-69.

### SLP services provided include:

- **Literacy program** - Adult learning program is provided if needed for individuals living in SLP.
- **Job readiness program** - Residents learn important skills to obtain employment.
- **Employment agency** - Job application assistance is provided by an employment agency.
- **Financial counseling** - Residents learn financial management and budgeting skills.
- **Healthcare** - Access to affordable healthcare services is provided by the Wishard Advantage program.
- **Transportation** - A Fairbanks van provides transportation for residents.
- **Food pantry** - Opportunities for shopping at the Fairbanks food pantry are provided weekly.
