
When inpatient rehabilitation is necessary, Fairbanks can help. Our experienced doctors, nurses and specialists work with patients to find the best start to their road to recovery.

Detox

Designed for individuals likely to experience serious withdrawal complications, detoxification (detox) is a medically managed service. Patients are medically stabilized and detoxified under 24-hour professional supervision. A comprehensive evaluation is conducted during this stage of treatment to determine the appropriate course for ongoing care. Unique, complementary therapies such as Acudetox (acupuncture) are available.

Rehab

By providing a structured inpatient environment, rehabilitation (rehab) services combine the efforts of a multidisciplinary team with group therapy to meet the specific needs of men, women, young adults or adolescents in the early stages of recovery or after relapse. Medical observation continues during rehab, but patients usually do not require withdrawal intervention.



Co-occurring Disorders

Individuals who have both a substance-use disorder and a mental-health disorder such as anxiety, depression or trauma require an integrated approach to care. Under the direction of our staff psychiatrist, evidence-based treatment programs are designed to meet the unique needs of each patient.

Residential Treatment

Residential treatment is designed for individuals who no longer require medical observation, but still require a structured environment in order to abstain from using drugs and alcohol. Fairbanks offers both shorter- and longer-term residential programs.
